- a) The Regiment will take part in one of our most important events of the year – Return to Manassas (**Early-War Impressions**).
- b) This will be the second main event of the year for the “Southern Division” and start the ball rolling for the 150s! A lot of great fighting on some great ground!
- c) This will be our long distance event of the year (about 50 miles northeast of Gettysburg but, very easy to get to. Instead of turning east at Chambersburg and driving the 30 minutes to Gettysburg, you will instead continue north on I-81 about that same distance and time and then turn east.
- d) The site has been used for a number of years as ground for 48 hour tacticals and offers period buildings, dirt roads through woods and fields, and a railroad embankment. It simply reads – Second Manassas. Start making your plans now for this event as we need to take a strong battalion and brigade north to the fights!!!
- e) We need to take a large battalion to Pennsylvania and show our support for the newly created Division and Brigade...I realize this is about an hour past Gettysburg but, let’s all start planning our rides early...this event will be over at 12 noon on Sunday, thus you will be on the road early!!!
- f) The sight is almost unbelievable as there are not many times that the terrain matches the event...there are historic buildings, a railroad cut, dirt roads, open fields, and woods...
